

As we get nearer the date for work experience placements it's time for students to contact their employer to check on a variety of issues to do with their placement. This may include: start times, end times, lunchtime arrangements (all students must remain on site at this

time), what to wear, who to report to on the first day and any other relevant points. Students will be given a preparatory session in school on June 22. They will each be given a Health and Safety booklet and a Placement Diary which should be filled in each day on their placement. All parents will receive a copy of the employers' risk assessment before the placement begins. If there are any points parents need clarification regarding the risk assessment they should contact the employer. If a student has any health issue, it is the parents responsibility to contact the employer and pass this information to them. We are not allowed to do so from school. If any paperwork is still to be sent to school and this has been mislaid, all documents are available on the school web site (School Information - Work Experience). Please contact Miss Whittaker (Year 10) or Miss Hunt (Year 12) or Mr Rowlands if you need any further assistance.

The final deadline for organisation of placements through Careers Wales website and for submission of all paperwork is 17 June.
